Professor Heinz Fassmann (born 1955 in Düsseldorf, Germany) studied Geography, History and Sociology. He holds a chair for Applied Geography, Regional Research and Spatial Planning at the University of Vienna and is managing Director of the Institute of Urban and Regional Research of the Austrian Academy of Sciences. Prior to his current position he held a chair (C4) at the Technical University of Munich. In 2005 he was Fulbright professor at the Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, USA.

Heinz Fassmann is the author (or co-author) of more than 220 scientific articles and around 40 books, monographs or project reports. He is member of the Academia Europaea and Full Member of the Austrian Academy of Sciences. His main fields of research include the linkages between spatial development, the societal change and the influence of the political system. He is specialized in the field of demography, especially migration, in urban geography and in spatial planning. Moreover, he has extensive experience in the spatial impacts of the transformation process in the Central European region.
