Scientific profile as responsible of the Research Laboratory of Urban and Tourism Geography (RELUT) in the Department of Geography

Prof. Dr. Manuel VALENZUELA, leads two very consolidated research groups on **Urban and Tourism Geography** currently integrated into the **Research Laboratory of Urban and Tourism Geography (RELUT)**. He got his PhD degree at the **Universidad Complutense de Madrid** (1973) and was appointed as **professor of Human Geography** at the **Autonomous University of Madrid (UAM)** in 1981. From the beginning of his academic career he has developed two research lines: **Urban Geography** and **Geography of Tourism and Leisure**. He has been involved to a great extent in all the basic and applied projects carried out by the above mentioned research groups. He is currently collaborator in the above quoted subjects with local, regional and state agencies devoted to urban and tourism research and application. He belongs to the advisory boards of scientific geographic reviews at spanish level (**Investigaciones Regionales**) and at the european one (**Journal of Economic and Social Geography**) and at the same time he performs as referee for public research agencies and scientific journals. He has been from 1996 to 2002 member of the jury that every year selects the winner of the International Geography Award "**Vautrin Lud**".

Prof. Valenzuela has directed eight PhD doctoral researchs and written or coordinated, alone or in collaboration, twelve books, forty books chapters, fifty journals papers and a similar number of contributions to proceedings on topics such as urban tourism and planning, housing, leisure, urban peripheries and rural-urban fringes. He is a member of several networks on urban problems at European (ENHR, EURA, UNICA) and worldwide levels (UGI). He belongs to the Directory Board of the **Real Sociedad Geográfica** and to the spanish **Committee of the International Geographical Union (U.G.I.)**. Prof. Valenzuela has been for sixteen years a member of the UNESCO's **Man and Biosphere Programme** and an active member of the **Committee of the United Nations Habitat Programme** since 1996 until now.
