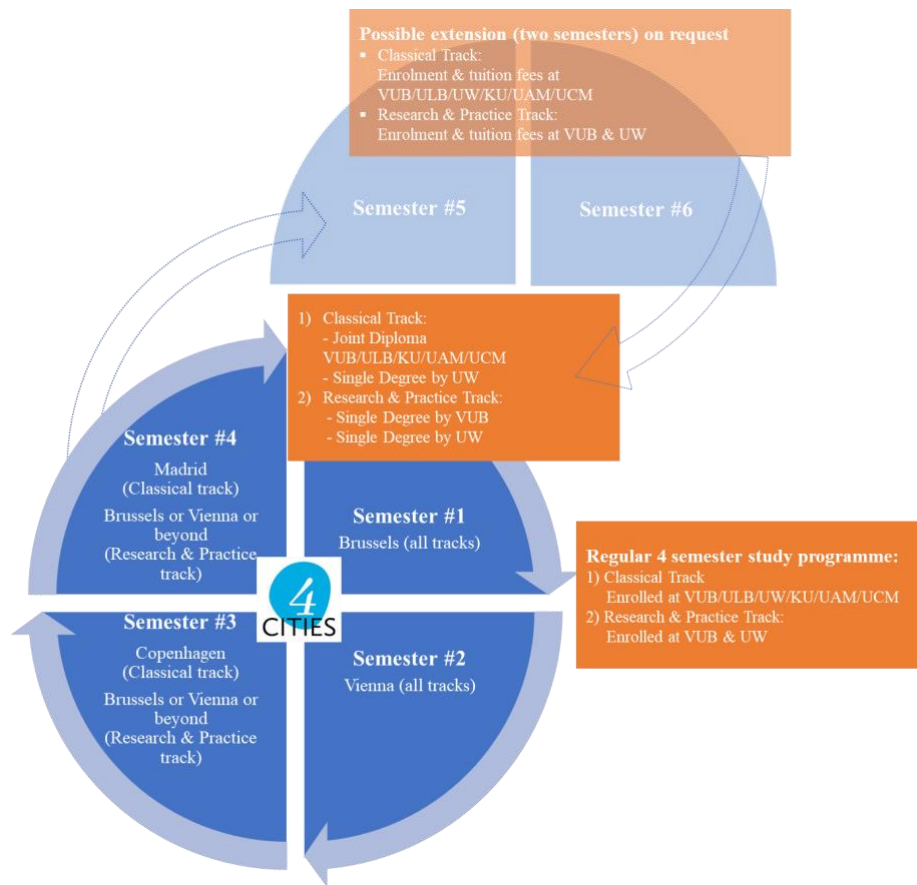


4CITIES Enrolment Rules 2021-2022



- The regular study duration of the 4Cities Master Programme is 4 semesters (degree: MSc. in Urban Studies)
- Enrolment is based on selection for either Classical/Practice/Research Track (assigned through application process)
 - First and second academic year:
 - For Classical Track*
Semester 1-4: Vrije Universiteit Brussel (VUB), Université libre de Bruxelles (ULB), University of Vienna (UW), Københavns Universitet (KU), Universidad Autónoma de Madrid (UAM) or Universidad Complutense de Madrid (UCM)
 - For Research and Practice Track*
Semester 1-4: Vrije Universiteit Brussel (VUB), University of Vienna (UW) and possibly at different universities across Europe based on Erasmus agreements for elective courses
- Degrees upon enrolment at the universities
 - Classical Track:* Joint Diploma VUB/ULB/KU/UAM/UCM, Single Degree by UW
 - Research & Practice Track:* Single Degree by VUB, Single Degree by UW
- Fees
 - Self-payer: EU-countries 3.000 € (reduced fee), non-EU countries 9.000 € (as of June 30th, 2021)

- Scholarships
 - Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree (EMJMD)
 - Procedure: through general application process via www.4cities.eu
 - **Attention:** EMJMD scholarships cannot be combined with other EU funded scholarships
 - Erasmus Mobility for *Classical Track* students, only:
 - Procedure: Application through UW for Outgoing KU in March academic year 1; Application through UW for Outgoing UAM in September academic year 2;
 - Enrolment for up to one additional academic year (= two additional semesters) is possible upon request:
 - Procedure: a request to enroll for a third year of studies should be sent by email to the programme director of 4CITIES (Prof. Bas van Heur) + the international coordination team (Stefan De Corte/Elena Solonina) no later than 2 days after the deliberation of the re-sit period (end of September)
 - The tuition fee will consist of the sum of tuitions fees requested by the universities issuing the diploma(s):
 - Classical Track: Vrije Universiteit Brussel, Université Libre de Bruxelles, Universität Wien, Copenhagen University, Universidad Autonoma de Madrid & Universidad Complutense de Madrid.
 - Research/Practice Track: Vrije Universiteit Brussel & Universität Wien.
 - The consortium will centralize the administrative follow-up and tuition payment at the coordinating institution without any additional charge
 - The student will receive one invoice to be paid to the coordinating institution at the start of the academic year
 - The coordinating institution will centralize the follow-up and pay the tuition fees to the partner institutions and supervise the enrolment at each of the universities
 - Indicative financial information¹: tuition fees for one additional academic year (= two additional semesters):
 - VUB: variable rate = flat rate (247,9 €) + 11,9 € per ECTS
 - ULB: administrative fee of 12 € (flat rate)
 - UW: administrative fee of 39 € (flat rate)
 - KU: no fee
 - UAM:
 - EU nationals: 360€ for thesis only (or 1080€ for thesis + Sustainable Cities)
 - Non-EU nationals: 840€ for thesis only (or 1260 € for thesis + Sustainable Cities)
 - UCM:
 - EU nationals: 360€ for thesis only (or 1080€ for thesis + Sustainable Cities)
 - Non-EU nationals: 840€ for thesis only (or 1260 € for thesis + Sustainable Cities)
- Example: an EU student who enrolls to finish her/his thesis in 2021-2022 pays a total of 1375,9 €. A non-EU student will pay 2335,9 €.
- Attention: fees subject to change depending on the tuition policy of the participating universities.
